



Doral, Fla. (June 20, 2014) – [Caribbean Radiation Oncology Center](#), recognized as one of the region’s premier medical facilities for advanced radiation therapy, has broken ground on a new-build, 9,000-square-foot facility at 3125 N.W. 84th Ave. in Doral, Fla., the company’s first outside of Puerto Rico.

City of Doral Mayor Luigi Boria and Miami-Dade County Commissioner Jose “Pepe” Diaz formally welcomed Caribbean Radiation Oncology Center and presented a certificate of congratulations to Dr. Pedro Serrano-Ojeda, president and radiation oncologist of the center. Other notable guests in attendance included President Larry Williams and Chairman Sheldon Anderson of the Beacon Council, among others.

The facility, which is expected to add an estimated 22 jobs and \$8.35 million in capital investment within three years to Miami-Dade County, anticipates a grand opening in the second quarter of 2015. South Florida-based ANF Group is the general contractor.

“I am honored by the warm welcome we’ve received from dignitaries, such as Mayor Boria and Commissioner Diaz, as well as The Beacon Council and Enterprise Florida, to name a few,” said Dr. Serrano-Ojeda. “Doral is an epicenter of Miami-Dade County’s international community, and a logical location for our new facility. We look forward to opening the center next year, and furthering patient resources for cancer treatment.”
