

Doral Relay for Life raises over \$113,000

Doral families, friends and neighbors came together for the city's annual Relay for Life, raising awareness and more than \$115,000 for the fight against cancer at Doral Central Park Apr. 11.

Caribbean Radiation Oncology Center, presenting sponsor, and Miami community leaders who included Doral Mayor Luigi Boria, Miami-Dade County Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz and Doral Councilwoman Christi Fraga were among those who kicked off the event with a proclamation honoring April 11, 2015 as "Relay for Life Day."

Dr. Pedro Serrano-Ojeda and Carmen I. Bigles, co-founders of Caribbean Center, began the relay with the introduction of the survivor's lap with cancer survivors proudly walking the track to celebrate their victory over cancer, cheered by an enthusiastic crowd.
